What is the Census?

The census counts everyone living in the United States on April 1st, 2010. This count includes people of all ages, races, ethnic groups—both citizens and non-citizens.

Who benefits by filling out the census?

- You
- Your family
- Your community
- Your ethnic group

What's in it for me?

Census affects funding in YOUR community—

- It helps determine how more than \$400 billion a year is given to communities for neighborhood improvements, public health, education, transportation and more

If you don't fill out the census form, your community could lose out and not get its fair share

It's easy and fast

- The 2010 Census is a short form, it will take only a few minutes to fill it out
- There are only seven simple questions
- It's coming, look for it in the mail and send it back!
- The form is available in many languages

It's Safe

- Your answers are confidential
- The Census Bureau cannot give out information that identifies you
